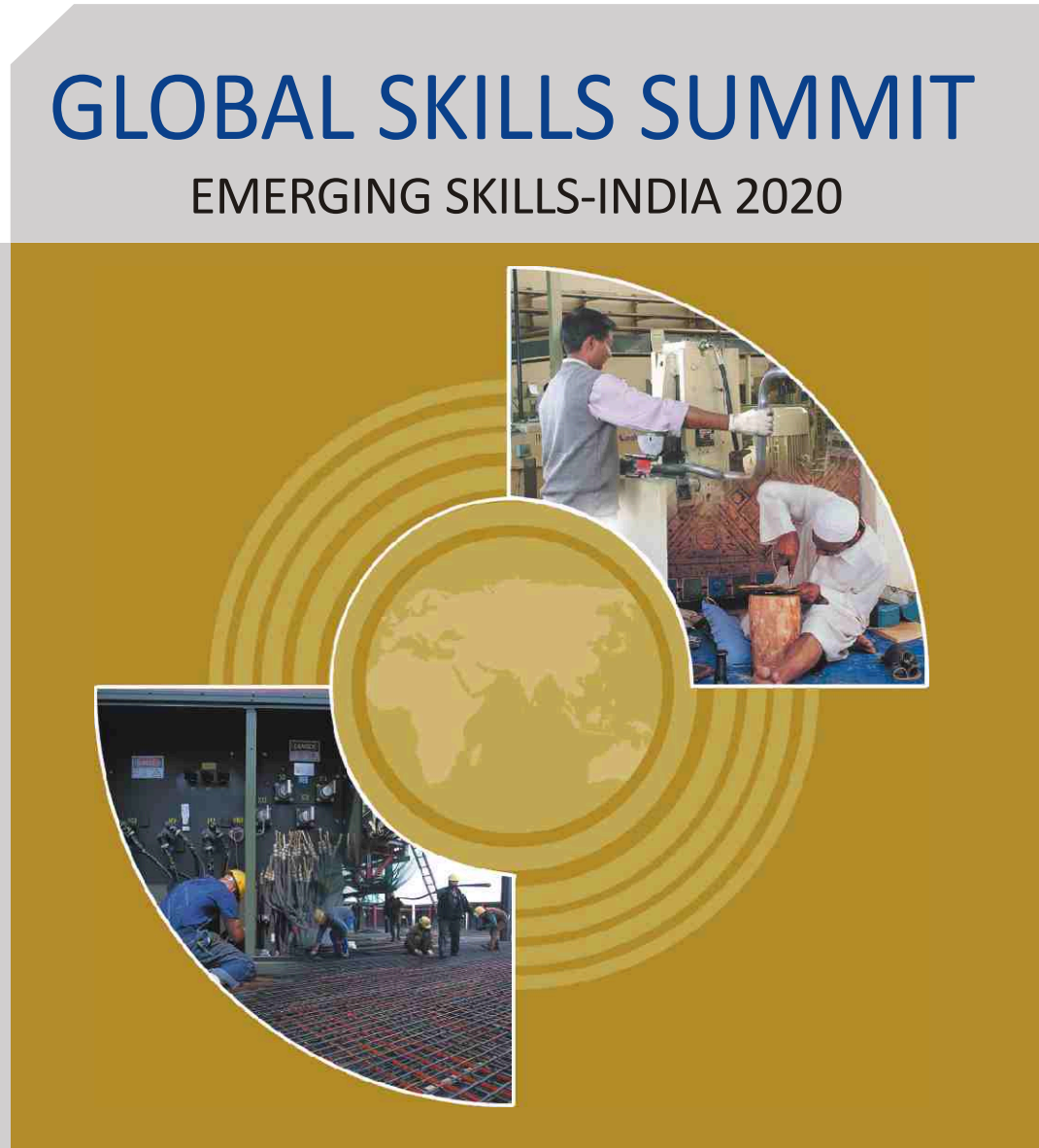

BACKGROUND

'Skills and knowledge' are the driving forces of economic growth and social development. Countries with higher and better levels of skills adjust more effectively to the challenges and opportunities of globalization.

To focus on this theme, FICCI organised the Global Skills Summit 2008, which was held on 21st-22nd August 2008 at New Delhi. OBJECTIVES OF THE SUMMIT

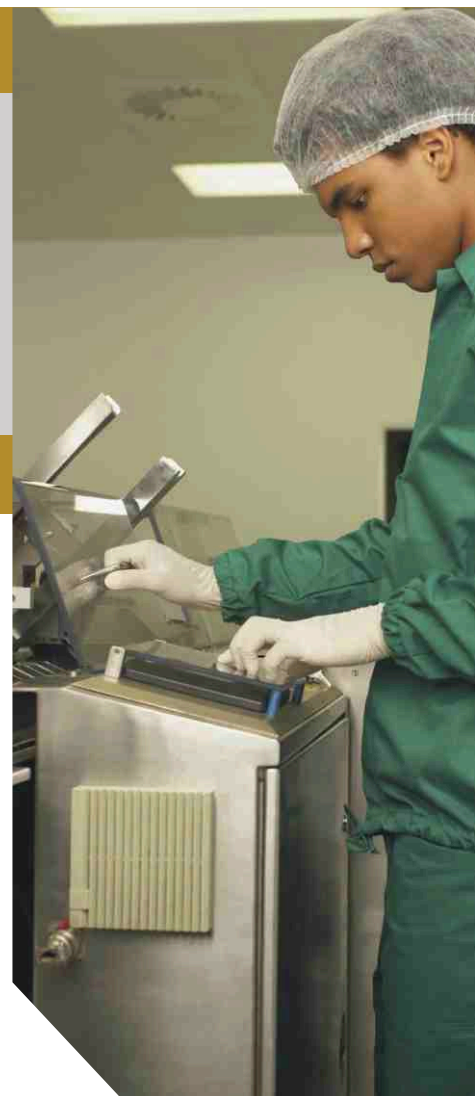
- To take forward the lessons learnt from the Global Skills Summit 2008 and understand and reveal the potential of Skill Development in India and focus on employability for all.

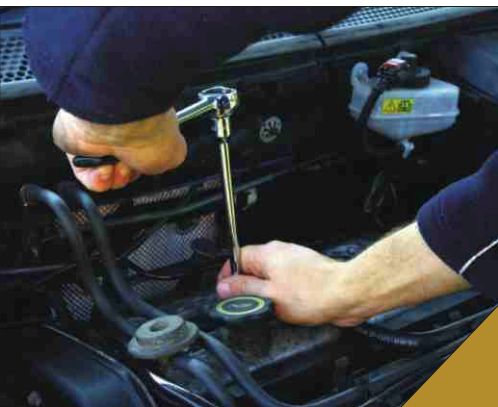
