3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

- Clean industrial and sewage facilities according due consideration to preparatory measures, health and safety at work and environmental protection
- Operate, monitor, inspect and maintain machines, equipment and special vehicles using technical safety facilities and personal protective equipment
- Assist in the proper professional disposal of residual waste materials produced in cleaning, industrial maintenance, pipe and sewer cleaning work
- Document and evaluate work and operational processes
- Identify and rectify operational malfunctions of work equipment
- Exchange solid and liquid auxiliary materials
- Assemble and dismantle plant components for the purpose of industrial maintenance
- Use physical and chemical cleaning procedures
- Assist in the analysis of operational malfunctions
- Apply relevant legal provisions and technical rules
- Work in a customer and service oriented manner and use information and communication technologies
- Take responsibility/ carry out work autonomously on the basis of technical documentation and rules and in compliance with the relevant legal stipulations
- Plan, control and monitor technical work processes
- Procure information
- Plan and coordinate work
- Document performance and initiate quality assurance measures, measures for health and safety at work and measures for environmental protection
- Work in an environmentally sustainable and cost-effective manner whilst remaining aware of hygiene.

6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

<p>Final examination administered by the competent body:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. after completion of dual training in a company and at part-time vocational school (normal procedure) 2. after retraining in a recognized training occupation 3. as an external examination for working people without formal vocational qualifications or persons who have been trained at full-time vocational schools or other vocational training institutions
<p>Additional information</p> <p>Entry requirements: Entry requirements are not governed by legislation; as a rule, young people are admitted after completing (nine or ten years of) general education.</p> <p>Duration of training: 3 years.</p> <p>Training in the "dual system": Teaching of the knowledge, skills and competences needed for an occupation is based on the typical requirements of work and business processes and prepares the trainees for a specific job. The training is provided in a company and at part-time vocational school: In the company, the trainees acquire practical skills in a real working environment.
