3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

- Build formwork for foundations, right-angle supports and beams, and flat-run walls and ceilings
- Erect, brace and anchor formwork
- Produce concrete formwork for conical forms, column heads, landings and straight staircases
- Produce formwork for visible concrete
- Build and install reinforcing members and prepare reinforcement elements
- Test fresh and hardened concrete
- Deliver, feed and compress concrete and treat the surface manually and mechanically
- Cure concrete
- Build, store, transport and install prefabricated reinforced concrete units
- Seal concrete and reinforced concrete constructions against moisture
- Build interior and exterior walls using various types of block and slab and a range of bonding techniques
- Install materials to insulate against heat, cold, noise and fire
- Carry out related works in the construction and civil engineering sectors
- Work autonomously either alone or in conjunction with others to execute works on the basis of technical documentation and work orders
- Plan and coordinate work
- Set up construction sites
- Stipulate stages of work and initiate measures to safeguard the work process and ensure safety, health and safety at work and environmental protection at the construction site
- Check the quality of the work for any errors in execution, document works and clear the workplace
- Use equipment and machinery
- Erect work, load bearing and protective scaffolding and calibrate plant components and construction machinery sub-assemblies.

4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THE CERTIFICATE (1)

Building construction workers are mainly employed by companies in the construction sector. Depending on their specialism, these may include, for example, civil engineering companies or companies involved with concrete construction or the production of chimneys and industrial furnaces.

## 6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

Final examination administered by the competent body:

1. after completion of dual training in a company and at part-time vocational school (normal procedure)
2. after retraining in a recognized training occupation
3. as an external examination for working people without formal vocational qualifications or persons who have been trained at full-time vocational schools or other vocational training institutions

**Additional information**

**Entry requirements:** Entry requirements are not governed by legislation; as a rule, young people are admitted after completing (nine or ten years of) general education.

**Duration of training:** 2 years.

**Training in the "dual system":**

Teaching of the knowledge, skills and competences needed for an occupation is based on the typical requirements of work and business processes and prepares the trainees for a specific job. **The training is provided in a company and at part-time vocational school:** In the company, the trainees acquire practical skills in a real working environment. On one or two days per week, the trainees attend part-time vocational school, where they are taught general and vocational knowledge related to their training occupation.
