3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

- Produce shutter curtains and fabric hangings from semi-finished parts
- Produce, deliver and install roller shutters, awnings and blinds
- Install gates and rolling grills whilst according due consideration to the manufacturer's instructions
- Produce and install roller shutter and window combinations
- Install drives and control systems and programme such systems in accordance with customer requirements
- Plan and execute energy-saving measures
- Implement safety and anti-burglary measures during the production, installation and repair of roller shutters, windows and doors
- Carry out and document safety and functional tests
- Organise the transport of components, sub-assemblies and equipment
- Implement quality assurance measures whilst taking account of the correlations between quality, customer satisfaction and company success
- Work alone or as part of a team in conjunction with other trades to coordinate works in an autonomous and customer-oriented manner on the basis of work orders or plans
- · Set up, secure and clear workplaces
- Produce process materials, ancillary materials and semi-finished products
- Handle, operate and maintain tools, equipment, machines and technical plants
- Prepare, implement and document maintenance and repair measures
- · Hand over services, conduct customer discussions, record further customer requirements and check the feasibility of such requirements
- Invoice services provided and initiate safety, health and safety at work and environmental protection measures in the workplace.

Roller shutter and sunshade mechatronics technicians mainly work at craft trade companies specialising in roller shutter and sunshade technology and at industrial manufacturers of roller shutter and sunshade systems.

6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

Final examination administered by the competent body:

- 1. after completion of dual training in a company and at part-time vocational school (normal procedure)
- 2. after retraining in a recognized training occupation
- 3. as an external examination for working people without formal vocational qualifications or persons who have been trained at full-time vocational schools or other vocational training institutions

Additional information

Entry requirements: Entry requirements are not governed by legislation; as a rule, young people are admitted after completing (nine or ten years of) general education.

Duration of training: 3 years.

Training in the "dual system":

Teaching of the knowledge, skills and competences needed for an occupation is based on the typical requirements of work and business processes and prepares the trainees for a specific job. **The training is provided in a company and at part-time vocational school**: In the company, the trainees acquire practical skills in a real working environment. On one or two days per week, the trainees attend part-time vocational school, where they are taught general and vocational knowledge related to their training occupation.
