To support national monitoring and national education reporting on the integration of education for sustainable development in vocational education and training (BBNE), the BIBB will collect the indicator “Continuing education of training personnel in the field of sustainability” (IndAu-Na) as part of the BIBB **Establishment Panel on Training and Competence Development** (BIBB Training Panel). The indicator will be collected regularly in the BIBB Training Panel in the future. In the 2023 and 2025 survey waves, an additional module will therefore be included in the BIBB Training Panel, which will be financed by the BMBF.

The additional module is intended to determine the extent to which firms have provided further training to their training staff on the topic of vocational education and training for sustainable development (BBNE). The information derived from this will make it possible to assess whether the binding requirement to integrate vocational education and training for sustainable development as a compulsory component of dual training (see BMBF press release 052/2020) in the new standard occupational profile “Environmental Protection and Sustainability” will lead to firms providing the relevant teaching skills. Since there are no uniform databases for in-company continuing education, the information needed to provide this indicator would have to be collected separately. The indicator is used to support national monitoring and national education reporting on the integration of education for sustainable development in vocational education and training (BBNE).
