The project aims to pilot a detailed yet coherent information system for monitoring skilled workers in the healthcare sector for the BMAS, which can be used to record and project the supply and demand for relevant healthcare and nursing professions. The proposed concept for BMG skilled worker monitoring (see feasibility study) is designed in such a way that, with a pilot implementation of the model, answers to various questions regarding the securing of skilled workers can be provided with little effort, e.g., on the demand for health and care services, the number of skilled workers employed in the future, or the effects of productivity gains. The supply and demand projections outlined in the projection concept also offer levers for numerous scenario analyses in order to identify starting points for political action and to better assess the consequences of measures to adequately remedy matching problems.
